Neges gan Gadeirydd y Llywodraethwyr

Pleser mawr yw cael cyflwyno ein hadroddiad ar gyfer blwyddyn academaidd 2018/2019. Dros y flwyddyn ddiwethaf mae'r Llywodraethwyr wedi gweithio'n galed i sicrhau bod eich plant yn cael addysg o'r safon uchaf. Mae'r adroddiad hwn wedi'i fwriadu i ddangos i chi, fel rhieni, rai o'r pethau yr ydym yn eu gwneud wrth inni fonitro gwaith yr ysgol. Fel Llywodraethwyr mae gennym gyfrifoldeb i weithio gyda'r Pennaeth, yr Uwch Dîm Arwain a'r staff i ddarparu amgylchedd dysgu cyffrous a bywiog ar gyfer disgyblion yr ysgol. Eleni, rydym wedi bod yn ffodus iawn i dderbyn cefnogaeth gan yr awdurdod lleol i gwblhau addasiadau mewnol. Bydd yr ardal ddysgu newydd hefyd yn cael ei ddefnyddio ar gyfer gweithgareddau grŵp a gwersi cerdd.

Daw Llywodraethwyr yr ysgol o amrywiaeth o gefndiroedd ac maent yn gwirfoddoli eu hamser a'u harbenigedd i sicrhau bod yr ysgol yn cyrraedd y safonau uchaf posibl a'i bod yn chwarae rhan weithredol ym mywyd y gymuned. Eleni rydym wedi croesawu dau Lywodraethwr Awdurdod Lleol newydd, Mrs Helen Lowcock-James a'r Cynghorydd Keith Hughes a llywodraethwr athrawon newydd, Mr Emrys Roberts. Gadawodd ein llywodraethwr staff cymorth, Miss Elizabeth Evans ni ar ddiwedd y flwyddyn academaidd hon a dymunwn yn dda iddi wrth iddi ymgymryd a chwrs athrawon.

Unwaith eto eleni derbynodd y llywodraethwyr gyflwyniadau gan ein haelodau staff sydd â chyfrifoldebau ychwanegol, gan gynnwys datblygu TGCh, dysgu annibynnol, llythrennedd a rhifedd a'r Cyfnod Sylfaen. Mae llywodraethwyr yn ymdrechu i sicrhau bod ganddynt ddarlun clir o safonau yn yr ysgol ac yn gweithio'n agos gyda chydweithwyr yn yr ALI a Chonsortium Canol De i fonitro safonau dysgu a chyflawniad. Rydym wedi parhau â'n rolau fel llywodraethwyr cyswllt sydd â chyfrifoldeb penodol i ganolbwyntio ein hymweliadau yn yr ysgol ar feysydd allweddol. Rydym wedi cynnal ein cyfarfod categoreiddio gyda'n Cynghorydd Her a bydd canlyniad hyn ar gael ym mis Ionawr 2020 trwy'r sianeli arferol.

Yn dilyn adborth gan rieni, rydym yn treialu clwb brechwast ar safle'r ysgol, i ddarparu brechwast am ddim i ddisgyblion o oedran addysg statudol cyn y diwrnod ysgol prysur. Byddwn yn cwrdd â staff yr ysgol a'r ALI i adolygu canlyniad y treial a bydd yr ysgol yn hysbysu rhieni yn ddiweddarach yn y tymor a yw'r treial clwb brechwast wedi bod yn llwyddiannus.

Mae gan y Corff Llywodraethu gyfrifoldeb penodol am sicrhau bod y gyllideb yn cael ei gwario'n ddoeth. Mae Cyngor Bwrdeistref Sirol Pen-y-bont ar Ogwr wedi ein cynghori i gynllunio ar gyfer toriadau i'r gyllideb yn y dyfodol ac mae hyn yn golygu mai ychydig iawn o arian fydd dros ben. Mae'r Llywodraethwyr yn monitro gwariant yn ofalus ac fel ysgol rydym yn cyflawni gwerth ardderchog am arian, ond mae'n gyfnod o gyni cyllidol felly rydym yn diolch i Ffrindiau Bro Ogwr a'u cefnogwyr am godi arian bob blwyddyn er mwyn inni allu darparu'r pethau ychwanegol hynny na all cyllideb yr ysgol dalu amdanynt.

Yn olaf, hoffai'r Corff Llywodraethu ddiolch i Mrs Jayne a'i staff yn yr ysgol am eu gwaith caled a'u hymrwymiad i addysg y disgyblion yn Ysgol Gymraeg Bro Ogwr. Trwy gydol y flwyddyn rydym yn parhau i adeiladu perthnasoedd â staff fel ein bod yn gallu cynnal cydbwysedd rhwng cefnogaeth a her a gobeithiwn y byddwn yn cyflawni hyn.

Byddwn ni fel Corff Llywodraethu yn parhau i wneud pob ymdrech i sicrhau llwyddiant yr ysgol ac edrychwn ymlaen at weithio gyda chi fel rhieni a chyda'r staff yn yr ysgol i ddarparu'r addysg orau un ar gyfer ein plant.

Message from the Chair of Governors

It gives me great pleasure to present to you our report for the academic year 2018/2019. Over the past year Governors have worked hard to ensure that the quality of education for your children is of the highest standard. This report is intended to show you, as parents, some of the things that we do as we monitor the work of the school. As Governors we have a responsibility to work with the Headteacher, Senior Leadership Team and staff to provide an exciting and vibrant learning environment for the pupils at the school. This year, we have been very fortunate to receive support from the local authority to complete some internal modification to increase our usable classroom space within the school. The new learning area will also be used for group activities and music lessons.

The Governors at the school come from a variety of backgrounds and volunteer their time and expertise to ensure that the school is the best it can be and that it plays an active part in the life of the community. This year we have welcomed two new Local Authority Governors, Mrs Helen Lowcock-James and Cllr Keith Hughes and a new teacher governor, Mr Emrys Roberts. Our support staff governor, Miss Elizabeth Evans left us at the end of this academic year and we wish her well with her teacher training.

Governors have again this year received presentations from our staff members with additional responsibilities, including ICT development, independent learning, literacy and numeracy and the Foundation Phase. Governors strive to ensure that they have a clear picture of standards within the school and work closely with LA colleagues and the Central South Consortium to monitor standards of learning and achievement. We have continued our roles as link governors with specific responsibility to focus our visits in school on key areas. We have held our categorisation meeting with our Challenge Advisor and the outcome of this will be available in January 2020 via the usual channels.

Following parent feedback, we are trialling a breakfast club on the school site, to provide free breakfast to pupils of statutory schooling age before the busy school day. We will meet with the school and LA staff to review the outcome of the trial and the school will notify parents later in the term as to whether the breakfast club trial has been successful.

One of our responsibilities is ensuring that the budget is spent wisely. Bridgend County Borough Council has advised us to plan for budget cuts in future and this means that there will be little money to spare. Governors monitor spending carefully and as a school we achieve excellent value for money, but it is a time of austerity and so we thank Ffrindiau Bro Ogwr and its supporters for fundraising every year in order that we can provide those extras which the school budget cannot accommodate.

Finally, the Governing Body would like to thank Mrs Jayne and her staff at the school for their hard work and commitment to the education of the pupils at Ysgol Gymraeg Bro Ogwr. Throughout the year we continue to build relationships with staff so that we are able to maintain a balance between support and challenge and we hope we achieve this. We as a Governing Body will continue to make every effort to ensure the success of the school and look forward to working with you as parents and with the staff at the school to provide the very best education for our children.

4. PRESENOLDEB / ATTENDANCE

95% oedd presenoldeb y disgyblion ar gyfer blwyddyn academaidd 2018 / 2019. Roedd hyn yn is na'n targed ar gyfer presenoldeb eleni ond yn gyfartal gyda'r canran disgwyliedig cenedlaethol o 95%. Hoffem annog rhieni/gwarcheidwaid i weithio gyda'r ysgol i sicrhau bod disgyblion yn mynychu'r ysgol yn feunyddiol ac yn brydlon ac i leihau ar wyliau yn ystod tymor ysgol lle posib. Mae presenoldeb a phrydlondeb yn cael eu monitro'n barhaus gan y Pennaeth a'r Uwch Dîm Arwain ar y cyd â'r Swyddog Lles Addysg a'n llywodraethwr cyswllt ar gyfer presenoldeb.

Pupil attendance for the academic year 2018 / 2019 was 95%. This was below our target for attendance this year but in line with the National expectation of 95%. We encourage parents/carers to work with the school to ensure that pupils attend school daily and punctually and limit holidays during term time where possible. Attendance and punctuality are continually monitored by the Headteacher and Senior Leadership Team in liaison with our Education Welfare Officer and our link governor for attendance.

13. Y CWRICWLWM A DULLIAU ADDYSGU / CURRICULUM AND TEACHING METHODS

Y Cyfnod Sylfaen / Foundation Phase

Oed 3 – 7 Age

Yn y cyfnod hwn mae prif sylfeini profiadau dysgu'n cael eu gosod. Bydd y pwyslais ar ddatblygu sgiliau hanfodol cyfathrebu, llythrennedd a rhifedd. Trwy ddarparu cwricwlwm cyfoethog eang gan ddefnyddio dull integredig, ein nod yw datblygu diddordebau'r plant gan hefyd gydnabod eu lefel aeddfedrwydd. Mae'r rhain yn flynyddoedd pwysig lle mae'r plant yn dysgu sut i arsylwi, gwranddo, ymateb a datblygu nid dim ond fel unigolion ond hefyd fel aelodau gofalgwr o'n cymuned.

At this stage the main building blocks of learning experiences are laid. The emphasis will be on developing essential skills of communication, literacy and numeracy. By providing a broad rich curriculum using an integrated approach, we aim to develop the children's interests whilst also recognising their level of maturity. These are important years where children learn how to observe, listen, respond and develop not only as individuals but also as caring members of our community.

Cyfnod Allweddol 2 / Key Stage 2

Oed 7 -11 Age

Sgiliau hanfodol cyfathrebu, llythrennedd, rhifedd a TGCh yw ffocws canolog ein cwricwlwm. Ond, wrth i'w dealltwriaeth am wahanol ddisgyblaethau gynyddu, rhoddir mwy o bwyslais ar Wyddoniaeth a'r pynciau sylfaen. Bydd y cwricwlwm yn dal i ddigwydd o fewn themâu integredig lle mae'n ystyrlon ac yn berthnasol. Bydd plant yn cael eu hannog i ddatblygu hunanhyder, annibyniaeth wrth ddysgu, cydnerthedd a sgiliau lefel uwch mewn ystod o sefyllfaoedd.

The essential skills of communication, literacy, numeracy and ICT are the central focus of our curriculum. But, as their understanding of the different disciplines increases, a greater emphasis is placed on Science and the foundation subjects. The curriculum will still take place within integrated themes where it is meaningful and relevant. Children will be encouraged to develop self-confidence, independence in learning, resilience and higher order skills in a range of situations.

14. CATEGORI IAITH A DEFNYDD O'R GYMRAEG / LANGUAGE CATEGORY AND USE OF THE WELSH LANGUAGE

Ysgol cyfrwng Cymraeg yw Ysgol Gymraeg Bro Ogwr. Y Gymraeg yw iaith swyddogol yr ysgol. Yn y Cyfnod Sylfaen addysgir pob pwnc trwy gyfrwng y Gymraeg. Yn yr Adran Iau addysgir pynciau trwy gyfrwng y Gymraeg heblaw am Saesneg, a gyflwynir ym Mlwyddyn 3. Mae Ysgol Gymraeg Bro Ogwr yn rhoi safon iaith ragorol i'r disgyblion o ran y Gymraeg ac yn sicrhau bod yr holl ddisgyblion yn gallu cael mynediad at amrywiaeth eang o destunau a gwmpesir gan y "Cwricwlwm Cymreig" a'r "Siarter Iaith".

Ysgol Gymraeg Bro Ogwr is a Welsh medium school. The Welsh language is the official language of the school. In Foundation Phase all subjects are taught through the medium of Welsh. In the Junior Department subjects are taught through the medium of Welsh apart from English, which is introduced in Year 3. Ysgol Gymraeg Bro Ogwr provides pupils with an

excellent standard of Welsh and ensures that all pupils are able to access a wide variety of topics covered by the “Curriculum Cymreig” and ‘Y Siarter Iaith’.

15. CYFLEUSTERAU TOILEDAU / TOILET FACILITIES

Ceir darpariaeth ddigonol o ran cyfleusterau toiledau ar gyfer disgyblion yn y Cyfnod Sylfaen (Meithrin, Derbyn, Blwyddyn 1 a Blwyddyn 2). Ceir cyfleusterau ar wahân ar gyfer bechgyn a merched ym Mlwyddyn 1 a Blwyddyn 2. Mae'r holl gyfleusterau ar gyfer y Cyfnod Sylfaen wedi'u lleoli ym mhrif adeilad yr ysgol.

Mae nifer y toiledau sydd ar gael yn ddigonol ar gyfer nifer y disgyblion yn yr Adran Iau. Ceir cyfleusterau digonol, ar wahân ar gyfer bechgyn a merched yn yr Adran Iau. Mae'r cyfleusterau wedi'u lleoli ym mhrif adeilad yr ysgol a hefyd yn y cabanau sydd wedi'u lleoli y tu ôl i adeilad yr ysgol.

Mae'r plant yn dda am edrych ar ôl ardaloedd yr holl doiledau ar y cyfan. Mae'r toiledau'n cael eu glanhau'n ddyddiol gan y Gwasanaethau Glanhau Corfforaethol a gyflogir yn yr ysgol. Mae unrhyw faterion gweithredol neu lanhau yn ystod y diwrnod ysgol yn cael sylw prydlon gan staff yr ysgol.

There is adequate provision of toilet facilities for pupils in the Foundation Phase (Nursery, Reception, Years 1 and 2). There are separate facilities for boys and girls in Years 1 and 2. All the facilities for Foundation Phase are located within the main school building.

The number of toilets available is adequate for the number of pupils in the Junior Department. There are separate, adequate facilities for boys and girls in the Junior Department. The facilities are located within the main school building and also in the demountable buildings situated at the rear of the school building.

All toilet areas are generally well looked after by the pupils. The toilets are cleaned daily by the Corporate Cleaning Services employed by the school. Any operational or cleaning issues during the school day are addressed promptly by school staff.

16. BWYTA'N IACH / HEALTHY EATING

Daeth y “Mesur Bwyta'n Iach mewn Ysgolion” i rym ar ddydd Llun 2 Medi 2013. Mae'r Ysgol wedi cael tystysgrif gan yr Awdurdod yn datgan bod y fwydlen a ddarperir gan Wasanaethau Arlwyo'r Awdurdod yn cydymffurfio'n llawn â'r safonau a nodir yn nogfen Llywodraeth Cymru “Blas am Oes”.

The “Healthy Eating in Schools Measure” came into force on Monday 2nd September 2013. The School has received a certificate from the Authority stating that the menu provided by the Authority's Catering Services is fully compliant with the standards set out in the Welsh Government document “Appetite for Life”.
