Neges gan Gadeirydd y Llywodraethwyr

Message from the Chair of Governors

It gives me great pleasure to present to you our report for the Academic Year 2019/2020, in what has been an unprecedented year for Welsh education. At the time of publication of the last annual report, nobody could have imagined what was in store for us in 2020 and that school would be closed for a long period of time. At the time of writing we continue to see effects of the virus, with pupils isolating pending test results a daily occurrence and, wider across the authority, bubbles of pupils isolating for longer periods of time. We continue to work with Mrs Jayne and the school team to ensure that we can provide as safe an environment as possible. The Governing Body would like to warmly thank Mrs Jayne and her staff at the school for their hard work and commitment to the education of the pupils at Ysgol Gymraeg Bro Ogwr and we thank you as parents/carers for adhering to the new and changing guidance and for helping your children through this time of uncertainty and change.

Over the past year Governors have worked hard to ensure that the quality of education provided for your children is of the highest standard. Governance is a volunteer role and our governors volunteer alongside work, family and personal commitments. Our governors at Bro Ogwr come from a variety of backgrounds and use their skills, knowledge and expertise to ensure that the school is the best it can be and that it plays an active part in the life of the community. Governors meet regularly and complete development training as standard. This year we have welcomed the following new governors: Miss Hannah-May Maddern, Mrs Eirian Rees, Mr Ceri Stephens, Mr Keith Hughes, Mrs Emma Martin and Mr Joshua Slade. Dr Claire Flay-Petty, Mr Tim Thomas and Mr Gwyn Derfel stepped down from governance with us to focus on other commitments and we warmly thank them for their invaluable support over recent years.

As Governors we have a responsibility to work with the Headteacher, Senior Leadership Team and staff to provide an exciting and vibrant learning environment for the pupils at the school. One of our responsibilities is ensuring that the budget is spent wisely. Governors monitor spending carefully and as a school we achieve excellent value for money, but it is a time of austerity and so we thank Ffrindiau Bro Ogwr and its supporters for fundraising every year in order that we can provide those extras which the school budget cannot accommodate.

As well as utilising the internally modified ‘Stiwdio’ space this year, we have also celebrated the success of the free BCBC Breakfast Club and welcomed substantial long-term investment in outdoor play equipment. We have already seen the children enjoying the new trim trail and climbing slide tower and the shade sails will bring some much needed shelter to the yard in the brighter weather. The school has also invested in an upgrade to the CCTV system on site. To further enhance communication between school and parents/carers, this year we will see the school launch the SIMS Parent App and a closed Facebook communication page.

We are currently holding a parent governor vacancy. We have been very pleased with recent interest in our parent governor vacancies and look forward to welcoming the successful applicant, once appointed.

3. DATA AR BERFFORMIAD / PERFORMANCE DATA

Ni chyhoeddwyd unrhyw ddata performiad eleni oherwydd Covid-19. Mae tîm yr ysgol yn parhau i fonitro cynnydd yr holl ddisgyblion ym Mro Ogwr a bydd cyllid cynllun dysgu ar garlam gan Lywodraeth Cymru yn ein galluogi i ddefnyddio ein tîm ymyraethau mewnol arbenigol i ddarparu cefnogaeth ychwanegol i blant sydd angen hyn, yn dilyn y cyfnod cau ysgol.

Mae'r llywodraethwyr yn parhau i fonitro data cynnydd trwy'r is-bwylgor Cwricwlwm, Data a Safonau a thrwy gyswilt agos â'n Cynghorydd Her Consortiw Canolog y De, Mr Duan Evans. Mae Mr Evans yn newydd i ni yn yr ysgol ond mae ganddo lawer iawn o brofiad yn y sector ac rydym yn ei groesawu i deulu'r ysgol.

No performance data was published this year due to Covid-19. The school team continues to monitor the progress of all pupils at Bro Ogwr and catch-up funding from the Welsh Government will enable us to utilise our specialist internal interventions team to provide additional support for children requiring this, following the period of school closure.

Governors continue to monitor progress data through the Curriculum, Data and Standards sub-committee and through close liaison with our Central South Consortium Challenge Advisor, Mr Duan Evans. Mr Evans is new to us at the school but has a great deal of experience in the sector and we welcome him to the school family.

4. PRESENOLDEB / ATTENDANCE

Hoffem annog rhieni/gwarcheidwaid i weithio gyda'r ysgol i sicrhau bod disgyblion yn mynchy'u'r ysgol yn feunyddiol ac yn brydlon ac i leihau ar wyliau yn ystod tymor ysgol lle posib. Gofynnwn i chi sicrhau eich bod yn cysylltu gyda'r ysgol ar ddiwrnod cyntaf absenoldeb gan nodi rheswm penodol ar gyfer yr absenoldeb. Mae presenoldeb a phrydlondeb yn cael eu monitro'n barhaus gan y Pennaeth a'r Uwch Dîm Arwain ar y cyd â'r Swyddog Lles Addysg a'n llywodraethwr cyswilt ar gyfer presenoldeb.

We encourage parents/carers to work with the school to ensure that pupils attend school daily and punctually and limit holidays during term time where possible. We ask that you contact the school on the first day of absence, noting the exact reason for the absence. Attendance and punctuality are continually monitored by the Headteacher and Senior Leadership Team in liaison with our Education Welfare Officer and our link governor for attendance.

5. GWEITHGAREDDAU CHWARAEON AC ALLGYRSIOL / SPORTING AND EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Mae'r ysgol wedi chwarae rhan lawn a gweithredol mewn llawer o weithgareddau chwaraeon ac allgyrsiol yn y sir yn ogystal â chystadlaethau cenedlaethol a'r rhai a drefnir gan Urdd Gobaith Cymru. Mae gwybodaeth am weithgareddau allgyrsiol a chwaraeon yn cael ei chyfleu'n eang gan yr ysgol; mae rhieni'n cael gwybodaeth reolaidd am ddigwyddiadau a chyflawniadau ac maent yn gallu dilyn digwyddiadau ar Drydar lle y bo'n bosibl. Hoffai'r Llywodraethwyr ddiolch i staff a rhieni am eu cefnogaeth i ddigwyddiadau allgyrsiol eleni ac fel ysgol rydym yn parhau i ddathlu nifer o lwyddiannau yn y maes hwn.

The school has taken a full and active part in many sporting and extracurricular activities within the county along with National competitions and those organised by Urdd Gobaith Cymru. Information about extracurricular and sporting activities are widely communicated by the school; parents are regularly updated with events and achievements and are able to follow events on Twitter where possible. Governors thank staff and parents for their support of extracurricular events this year and as a school we continue to celebrate many successes in this area.

12. Y CWRICWLWM A DULLIAU ADDYSGU / CURRICULUM AND TEACHING METHODS

Y Cyfnod Sylfaen / Foundation Phase

Oed 3 – 7 Age

Yn y cyfnod hwn mae prif sylfeini profiadau dysgu'n cael eu gosod. Bydd y pwyslais ar ddatblygu sgiliau hanfodol cyfathrebu, llythrennedd a rhifedd. Trwy ddarparu cwricwlwm cyfoethog eang gan ddefnyddio dull integredig, ein nod yw datblygu diddordebau'r plant gan hefyd gydnabod eu lefel aeddfedrwydd. Mae'r rhain yn flynyddoedd pwysig lle mae'r plant yn dysgu sut i arsylwi, gwrando, ymateb a datblygu nid dim ond fel unigolion ond hefyd fel aelodau gofalgar o'n cymuned.

At this stage the main building blocks of learning experiences are laid. The emphasis will be on developing essential skills of communication, literacy and numeracy. By providing a broad rich curriculum using an integrated approach, we aim to develop the children's interests whilst also recognising their level of maturity. These are important years where children learn how to observe, listen, respond and develop not only as individuals but also as caring members of our community.

Cyfnod Allweddol 2 / Key Stage 2

Oed 7 -11 Age

Sgiliau hanfodol cyfathrebu, llythrennedd, rhifedd a TGCh yw ffocws canolog ein cwricwlwm. Ond, wrth i'w dealltwriaeth am wahanol ddisgyblaethau gynyddu, rhoddir mwy o bwyslais ar Wyddoniaeth a'r pynciau sylfaen. Bydd y cwricwlwm yn dal i ddigwydd o fewn themâu integredig lle mae'n ystyrlon ac yn berthnasol. Bydd plant yn cael eu hannog i ddatblygu hunanhyder, annibyniaeth wrth ddysgu, cydnethedd a sgiliau lefel uwch mewn ystod o sefyllfaoedd.

The essential skills of communication, literacy, numeracy and ICT are the central focus of our curriculum. But, as their understanding of the different disciplines increases, a greater emphasis is placed on Science and the foundation subjects. The curriculum will still take place within integrated themes where it is meaningful and relevant. Children will be encouraged to develop self-confidence, independence in learning, resilience and higher order skills in a range of situations.

13. CATEGORI IAITH A DEFNYDD O'R GYMRAEG / LANGUAGE CATEGORY AND USE OF THE WELSH LANGUAGE

Ysgol cyfrwng Cymraeg yw Ysgol Gymraeg Bro Ogwr. Y Gymraeg yw iaith swyddogol yr ysgol. Yn y Cyfnod Sylfaen addysgir pob pwnc trwy gyfrwng y Gymraeg. Yn yr Adran Iau addysgir pynciau trwy gyfrwng y Gymraeg heblaw am Saesneg, a gyflwynir ym Mlwyddyn 3.

Mae Ysgol Gymraeg Bro Ogwr yn rhoi safon iaith ragorol i'r disgylion o ran y Gymraeg ac yn sicrhau bod yr holl ddisgyblion yn gallu cael mynediad at amrywiaeth eang o destunau a gwmpesir gan y "Cwricwlwm Cymreig" a'r "Siarter Iaith".

Ysgol Gymraeg Bro Ogwr is a Welsh medium school. The Welsh language is the official language of the school. In Foundation Phase all subjects are taught through the medium of Welsh. In the Junior Department subjects are taught through the medium of Welsh apart from English, which is introduced in Year 3.

Ysgol Gymraeg Bro Ogwr provides pupils with an excellent standard of Welsh and ensures that all pupils are able to access a wide variety of topics covered by the “Curriculum Cymreig” and ‘Y Siarter Iaith’.

14. CYFLEUSTERAU TOILEDAU / TOILET FACILITIES

Ceir darpariaeth ddigonol o ran cyfleusterau toiledau ar gyfer disgylion yn y Cyfnod Sylfaen (Meithrin, Derbyn, Blwyddyn 1 a Blwyddyn 2). Ceir cyfleusterau ar wahân ar gyfer bechgyn a merched ym Mlwyddyn 1 a Blwyddyn 2. Mae'r holl gyfleusterau ar gyfer y Cyfnod Sylfaen wedi'u lleoli ym mhrif adeilad yr ysgol.

Mae nifer y toiledau sydd ar gael yn ddigonol ar gyfer nifer y disgylion yn yr Adran lau. Ceir cyfleusterau digonol, ar wahân ar gyfer bechgyn a merched yn yr Adran lau. Mae'r cyfleusterau wedi'u lleoli ym mhrif adeilad yr ysgol a hefyd yn y cabanau sydd wedi'u lleoli y tu ôl i adeilad yr ysgol.

Mae'r plant yn dda am edrych ar ôl ardaloedd yr holl doiledau ar y cyfan. Mae'r toiledau'n cael eu glanhau'n ddyddiol gan y Gwasanaethau Glanhau Corfforaethol a gyflogir yn yr ysgol. Mae unrhyw faterion gweithredol neu lanhau yn ystod y diwrnod ysgol yn cael sylw prydlon gan staff yr ysgol.

There is adequate provision of toilet facilities for pupils in the Foundation Phase (Nursery, Reception, Years 1 and 2). There are separate facilities for boys and girls in Years 1 and 2. All the facilities for Foundation Phase are located within the main school building.

The number of toilets available is adequate for the number of pupils in the Junior Department. There are separate, adequate facilities for boys and girls in the Junior Department. The facilities are located within the main school building and also in the demountable buildings situated at the rear of the school building.

All toilet areas are generally well looked after by the pupils. The toilets are cleaned daily by the Corporate Cleaning Services employed by the school. Any operational or cleaning issues during the school day are addressed promptly by school staff.

15. BWYTA'N IACH / HEALTHY EATING

Daeth y “Mesur Bwyta’n Iach mewn Ysgolion” i rym ar ddydd Llun 2 Medi 2013. Mae'r Ysgol wedi cael dystysgrif gan yr Awdurdod yn datgan bod y fwydlen a ddarperir gan Wasanaethau Arwyo'r Awdurdod yn cydymffurfio'n llawn â'r safonau a nodir yn nogfen Llywodraeth Cymru “Blas am Oes”.

The “Healthy Eating in Schools Measure” came into force on Monday 2nd September 2013. The School has received a certificate from the Authority stating that the menu provided by the Authority’s Catering Services is fully compliant with the standards set out in the Welsh Government document “Appetite for Life”.
