Flu Vaccine

The health board will be visiting the school on Monday 9th of November to provide the nasal flu vaccine for pupils from Reception to Year 6. Parents/carers will receive a letter and information from the health board closer to the date.

Nursery pupils are not included in this school vaccination programme for the flu vaccine and parents/carers should contact their GP to arrange a personal appointment for these pupils at their usual practice.

PE / Uniform

Pupils are asked to attend school wearing their PE kit on PE days. School PE kit is suitable footwear, dark tracksuit bottoms and a white top. We kindly ask that you adhere to these colours and not allow bright, colourful clothing.

A minimum of two windows are open in all classrooms every day to allow for consistent natural ventilation. Please ensure that your child brings a jumper and coat to school, as the fresh air reduces the classroom temperature on cooler days.
