Dear Parents / Carers

### **Return to School**

### **Keeping Safe**

With the return of all pupils, this unfortunately does not mean a return to normal routine. Our strict operational and hygiene procedures will continue throughout the summer term. The importance of avoiding transmission is still a major priority for us all, therefore, we kindly ask you to respect the current national COVID rules along with any changes as and when they are implemented.

### **Parents' Evenings – Key Stage 2**

Parents' Evenings for all Key Stage 2 pupils (Year 3 to Year 6) will be held on Monday 26 April and Wednesday 28 April. Booking details will be sent out regarding these appointments this week. The text/on-line booking system will remain the same for you to be able to book a 10-minute appointment for the phone call. We ask that you keep to your appointment time and duration, to avoid causing unnecessary delay to later appointments. Staff will use the current main phone number registered on our database to contact you; if you would like to check or amend this please contact us or alternatively update this information via the Parent App.

### **School Uniform**

We kindly ask that pupils continue to wear school uniform with dark / black shoes where possible. Pupils are to wear PE kit to school on their allocated PE days and again, we kindly ask that these are school PE kit colours of a white top and dark bottoms.

Year 6 pupils are permitted to wear their school leavers' hoodies this term instead of their school jumper if they so wish to do so. This is a special exception for Year 6 only to wear a hoodie of their own choice during their last term with us here. All other pupils should continue to wear school colours and are not permitted to wear their own colourful hoodies.
