Dear Parents / Carers

I hope that you are all keeping well and safe. Here are the current updates from school.

### **Healthy Schools' Week**

Immediately after half term we will be holding a Healthy Schools' week. All pupils will be active on Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday in various activities and sports. Pupils are asked to wear PE kit to school on Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday this week **but not on Tuesday 8 June due to class photographs (see below)**. During Healthy Schools' week we are also encouraging pupils and parents to walk, cycle or scooter to school if you live locally and it is safe to do so. Safe cycle/scooter storage will be provided; please notify the office in advance if you intend to leave your child's bike/scooter at school during this week. Following parental feedback, please note that we intend to site a permanent cycle storage area at the school as part of our ongoing outdoor development plans and we will keep you updated on the progress of this.

The school photographer will be attending school on Tuesday 8 June to take class photos. **Full school uniform for the class photos please, where at all possible.**

### **Year 6 Transition**

All Year 6 pupils have now logged on to and accessed their Google Classroom account linked to YGG Llangynwyd. A Microsoft Teams assembly has been scheduled for Friday 11 June for Year 6 pupils with Mr Owain Tudur (Year 7 leader). Pupils will be asked to send in their questions to Mr Tudur regarding their transition to Llangynwyd. A video presentation will then be created by Mr Tudur to answer all points raised. Mr Tudur and Mrs Woodrow will also be attending YG Bro Ogwr to meet the pupils in person later in the term to further discuss their transition to YGG Llangynwyd and will provide a transition pack in preparation for September. Here at Bro Ogwr we are finalising arrangements for an end of primary school farewell to our Year 6 pupils and details will be provided as soon as possible to Year 6 parents/carers.

### **Stopping/parking outside school grounds**

To ensure a safe area for families approaching the school site, we ask that parents/carers refrain from stopping on the markings immediately outside the school gate and continue to park legally and safely when parking outside school grounds, respecting any road markings and junctions.
