### **Class / Year Group Photographs**

A whole Year group photograph pack has been ordered for each pupil as an end of Primary leavers' gift from the school to our Year 6 families. This includes a whole year group and individual photograph. These will not be required to be ordered by yourselves. Further copies may be ordered through Colorfoto, if required.

You will have an option to purchase a Class photograph of your child's form class (6R or 6ER) – this is a 'montage' of each individual photograph taken from your child's class. You will receive a code to order these on line via Colorfoto, if you so wish to do so.

### **Year 6 Transition**

All Year 6 pupils should by now have logged on to and accessed their Google Classroom account linked to YGG Llangynwyd. If there are any issues logging on, please contact Mrs Roderick or Mr Roberts in the first instance to resolve. A Microsoft Teams assembly took place on Friday 11 June for Year 6 pupils with Mr Owain Tudur (Year 7 leader). Pupils were asked to send in their questions to Mr Tudur regarding their transition to Llangynwyd. A video presentation will then be created by Mr Tudur to answer all points raised. Mr Tudur and Mrs Woodrow will also be attending YG Bro Ogwr to meet the pupils in person later in the term to further discuss their transition to YGG Llangynwyd and they will provide a transition pack in preparation for September on 12.07.21 with information and contact details.

### **End of Primary 'Farewell'**

Due to the current restrictions on the numbers of people allowed to meet inside, we will not be able to hold a farewell assembly in the school hall. However, we want to celebrate their time here with us and say farewell to the pupils and yourselves. We will be holding a farewell afternoon on the school field for each class. Pupils will be on stage and you will be invited, per class, to attend the school field and bid farewell to your children. Due to the restrictions on numbers and space on the field, a maximum of two adults per pupil will be permitted to attend and we will ensure that seating will be 2 metres apart on the field between adult pairs. We will not be issuing tickets for the event, but have reserved two seats for each pupil. Unfortunately, we will not be able to offer any spare seats to extended family members as seating plans will be in place in line with our risk assessment. Hand sanitiser will be provided on arrival and masks will need to be worn at all times unless seated or exempt. Any pre-school age children may accompany parents if no other childcare is available. Siblings will not be able to accompany parents due to number restrictions. Unfortunately, we will be unable to provide any refreshments. Photographs will be permitted if for personal use only and not shared on any social media site without the permission of all pupils in the photograph.
