Reception class enjoyed a fun filled day in 'Area 51' and the beach. All children had a great time and were excellent at building sandcastles.



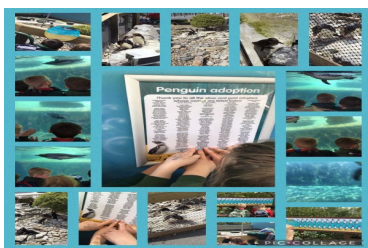
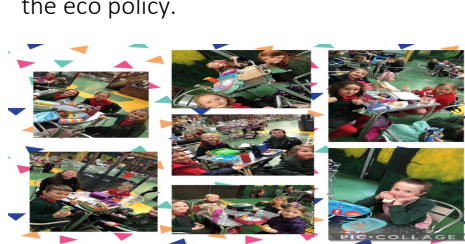

A caterpillar also arrived in the class for the children to watch developing.



Year 1 spent their end of year fun trip at Cefn Mably Fun Park and had a wonderful time and met a variety of animals and had a ride on the park's train..



Year 2 were fortunate to visit Folly Farm for a school trip and the pupils were excited when they located the penguin enclosure and found our school name on a list on the wall. We were gifted a Penguin adoption by a parent as a Christmas gift and in keeping with the eco policy.



A local firefighter came to school to teach the dangers of fire and how to keep safe.

Italy was brought to school with 'Cooking together' and the children made pizzas from scratch and were able to take them home to taste.



Year 2 arrived at Porthcawl for their end of year trip and learnt about keeping safe at the seaside with Chris from the RNLI. They searched for fossils and dolphins and had a trip on an open top bus to see the sights. The children finished off a busy and pleasurable day with Lunch on the beach.



The 'Triawd Pres' nosily visited Reception and year 2 and played numerous well known songs that the children recognised and many children were chosen to play different instruments.



As part of our Healthy week as well as learning the importance of eating a healthy balanced diet and the importance of exercise all foundation phase classes joined in with a fitness session with Heini.



The Dog's Trust spoke to year's 2-5 on safe behaviour around dogs and happy dogs rule. The Education Team at Dogs Trust have some top tips for the children to ensure that dogs and children stay safe and happy in the home together.



Year 3 and 4 end of year fun trip took the children to 'Wiggleys farm' where they were able to feed the animal and sit down to a choice of lunch. The children learnt many new facts about the animal over the visit.



Years 3, 4 and 6 enjoyed learning about the importance of healthy eating. The 'food showdown roadshow' is a way to help young people grow into healthy, active and productive young adults with a Highly Interactive Healthy Eating Roadshow. Food Showdown emphasises how easy it is to cook a healthy, balanced meal using lots of fresh vegetables and fruit!



Years 3, 4 and 5 learnt amazing facts about animals such as feeding needs, living habitats, where the animals come from and where they are on the food chain. Animal club brought a wide range of animals to the session such as cuddly rabbits, unusual insects, giant snails and a mix of various reptiles. The children are free to decide if they wish to observe the animals or touch them. Many children will overcome their fears once they see their peers touching animals and make that first step of holding an animal they have never held before!



'Forces Fitness' visited years 4 and 6, the aim of the programme is to have a positive impact on individuals and make children more resilient to ACEs (Adverse Childhood Experiences). It will also have a positive impact on the overall well-being and healthcare of the children. This programme covers the key 'What Matters' statements and the twelve pedagogical principles of the new Welsh curriculum.



Year 5 visited Sain Ffagans and experienced being taught a lesson in the school from the 'Victorian Era'. The children were very well behaved and luckily nobody had to wear the 'Welsh Not'.



Rozz and Riley from 'Cariad Pet Therapy' returned to visit the children in year 5. Pet therapy provides many benefits in that dogs in particular can support in decreasing the feelings of anxiety and sadness as well as increasing physical activity.



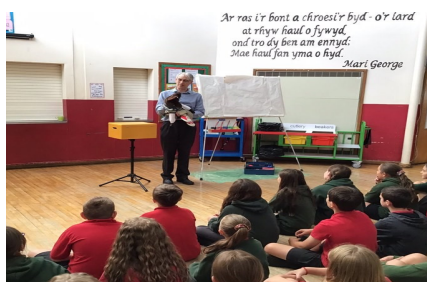
A fun filled day for year 5 end of year trip was had in Limitless in Swansea . A splash in the sea and numerous laughs were had whilst playing on Aberavon beach.



A police officer visited year's 5 and 6 to teach the children about keeping safe on their mobile phones and members of the Welsh Ambulance Services gave valuable CPR lessons to the children. The lessons taught the children how to perform CPR on CPR manikins.



Mr Coleman came to talk to year 6 regarding transitioning to comprehensive school and also spoke to year 5 and 6 about the importance of showing kindness to others during an assembly.



Year 6 visited the Principality Stadium to support BBSRU against Islwyn High Sport. The result ended in a 15 all draw and both teams shared the plate. Well done to the four players from Bro Ogwr that played in the game. Great talent and experience for all the under 11 players.



We have been fortunate for members of the Ospreys and Dragons rugby teams to visit us to provide sessions for years 5 and 6. Many new skills were learned in the sessions.



Children in year 6 enjoyed a martial arts session with Scorpions Bridgend. Martial arts focus on listening skills, hand eye co-ordination, balance and fun.



A experience of filming 'Pigo Dy Drwyn ' in a studio was had by year 6. 'Pigo dy drwyn' is a studio based gameshow for two teams of children and their supporters . This is the snottiest half hour ever, as the two teams battle it out in a series of games with zorbs, bungee ropes, bouncing platforms and a velcro.



A visit from Bush craft events taught children in year 6 about themselves, working with others, build confidence and more through outdoor activities. The children built a shelter, played archery, started a fire and toasted marshmallows on an open fire. The children thoroughly enjoyed the experience.



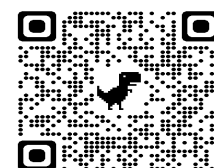
