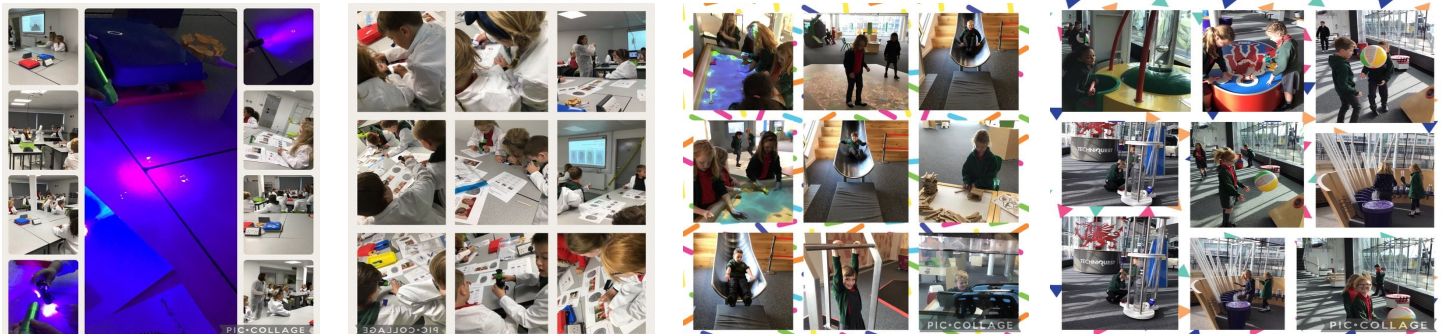

Year 6 visited Llangynwyd for their first transition day of the year. Everyone enjoyed making new friends and mixing with pupils from other schools.



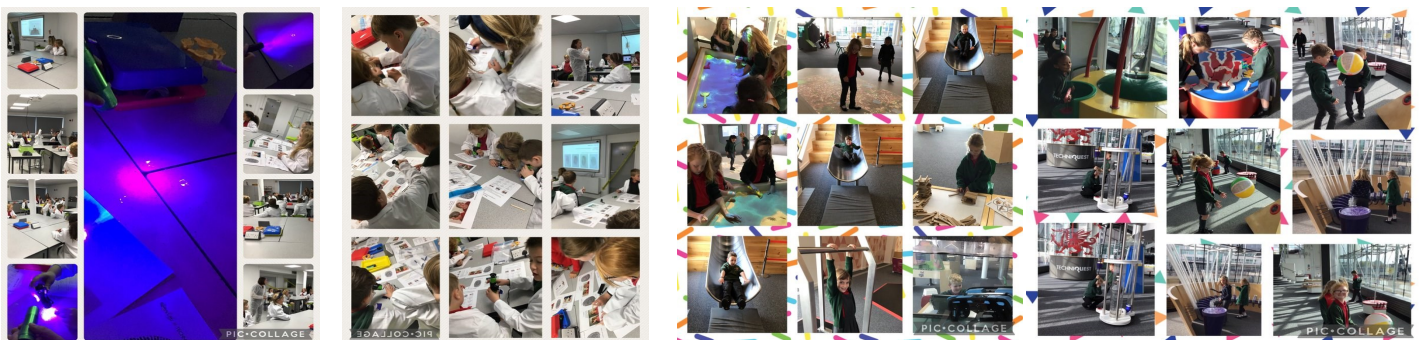
