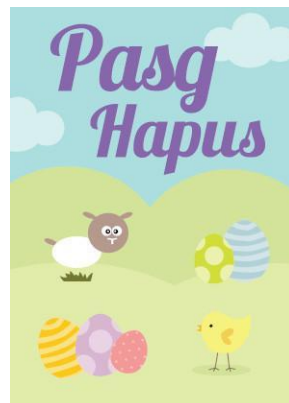
Dangosodd Bl 2 eu doniau cerddorol trwy greu cerddoriaeth gan ddefnyddio drymiau Affricanaidd.
