

### Ysgol Gymraeg Bro Ogwr

Daeth Charlie o'r Gweilch i ymweld â Blwyddyn 5 a 6. Years 5 and 6 were visited by Charlie from the Ospreys. Ospreys in the Community deliver inclusive sessions to mixed age groups and abilities across the region, such as wheelchair & visually impaired rugby, primary school & club engagement, touch rugby, and our popular rugby camps.



Year 5 visited the community allotment where they sampled fresh produce and learnt many facts and tips on growing your own vegetables. The children also enjoyed the walk around Brackla, where they compared how Brackla looks today compared to a 100 years ago.



The children in Year 3 & 4 learnt about the importance of recycling.

The fun workshop, teaches pupils why recycling is important for the environment and to reduce climate change.

Delivered by ADA Recycling Training and aimed at primary school aged pupils, it follows a set lesson plan and reinforces the work being done as part of the Eco Schools programme.

As well as being educational, there is lots of classroom interaction, and activities such as quizzes.

The children looked at what things they can recycle in school, what they are made of and how they can be recycled into new products.

Year 6 visited YGG Llangynwyd for the first transition day of the year. The children participated in Welsh, English and Numeracy classes. Parents were then welcome to visit the school and to attend an open evening.



The first cross country race was held for years 3-6 in Bryntirion Comprehensive School. Well done to everyone who participated and good luck for the rest of the season.



Welsh Water led an assembly for years 3-6. The award winning education team visited the school to give an assembly where they taught the children about all things to do with water! How they collect it, treat it, use it and clean it.

The interactive workshops were led by seconded teachers who educate children through the most creative lessons and equip children to become water ambassadors, with an understand about climate change, community and Welsh Water's business messages.



Year 6 visited a one-day coding workshop that covered a variety of different areas and is tailored to the abilities of the children. The workshop was developed and led by Steven Lewis, a fully qualified coding instructor. The children were taught STEM skills and the programme uses games such as Minecraft to introduce the pupils to various programming languages including Scratch and Python, which they would not normally encounter as part of the school curriculum.
