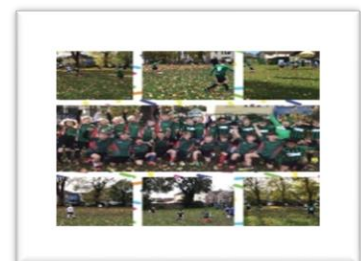

Ysgol Gymraeg Bro Oqwr

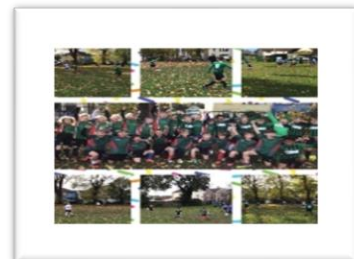
