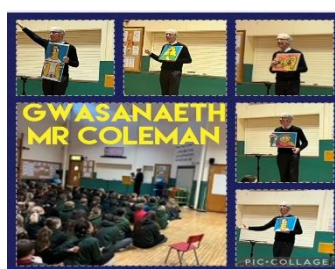

Da iawn i bawb a gymerodd rhan yn ein Eisteddfod ysgol. Pob lwc yn yr Eisteddfod Gylch.



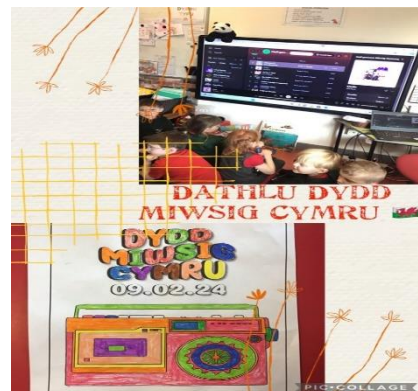
Clwb aml-sgiliau yn mwynhau gweld yr holl dechnoleg gwahanol sydd gan yr heddlu.

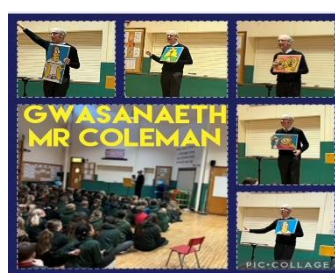
